

Our days were filled with things to do, unpacking and sorting of over 3,000 pounds of supplies, the tour, and visits to all of Padre Donahue's school projects, planning and setting up for our clinics, meeting the long-term volunteers and watching them with the children in the schools, visits to two public schools in the community, play time with the children of the orphanage, a tour of the hospital, a side trip to the caves (close to 3,000 years old) and a very emotional first-time visit to a new disability center in a neighboring town. We also threw a big birthday party for all the children of the orphanage at the Volunteer house filled with party favors, costumes, gift bags, a piñata, milk and of course cake. All the kids had a wonderful time as did each and every one of the team. The house was filled with happiness!!!! The entire team would like to thank everyone for their thoughts, prayers and donations that made this trip a huge success. We get to do all of this because of our family, friends, and you!!!! Muchos Gracias!! Padre will be coming to visit us here in Salem the end of April to thank you as well.

## A Tough Winter. Please help.

In January and February we spent over \$10,400 on plowing. #### **Christian Service Assistance**

In the last 14 months, our Parish community has been instrumental in providing \$47,473.50 in assistance to needy individuals and families in the area. This was made possible through fund-raising by several civic organizations in Salem that trusted us to pass those funds on to people in need. The remainder came from faithful parishioners in the pews who were moved to contribute to our fund this past year. The staff of our parish is deeply grateful and humbled to be your hands in meeting some of the shelter, heat, electricity and food needs in the Salem community. The following was provided: \$21,455.65 (shelter), (fuel \$9,020.00 oil), \$3,919.14 (electricity), \$5,640.35 (transportation), \$540.00 (prescription \$600.00 drugs), (gift \$4,599.86 (pantry food), and \$1698.50 (miscellaneous service projects).

#### Regulations for Fasting and Abstinence During Lent

FRIDAYS OF LENT are days of abstinence. FASTING is to be observed by all 18—59 years of age. On a fast day, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals can be eaten, sufficient to maintain strength, but together they should not equal another full meal. Eating between meals is not permitted, but liquids, including milk and juices, are allowed. ABSTINENCE is observed by all 14 years of age and older. On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed (unless work or health is affected).




