
Easter Flower Remembrance

SJRCS-What's Happening in our Science Classes?

Our 6th grade Science class just learned about Isaac Newton's three laws of motion and had to explain each in their own drawings. They are about



to start an exciting chapter on Light, Color, and Sound where they will learn what light is, what makes up the electromagnetic spectrum of color, and how sound is produced. 7th grade is learning about animal characteristics, symmetry, sponges, cnidarians, and earthworms. They will be figuring out whether an earthworm prefers day or night before we put them back into their natural habitat. They will also be learning about the complexity of an earthworm's body through dissection. 8th grade has been learning about the solar system and just finished learning about the differences in our eight planets. They are now learning about stars and the differences among the brightness and magnitude of each type. 8th grade will be learning about weather next and seeing what it entails to make an accurate forecast. Mrs. Denison hopes the weather will finally warm up so each Science class can learn and do labs outside!




