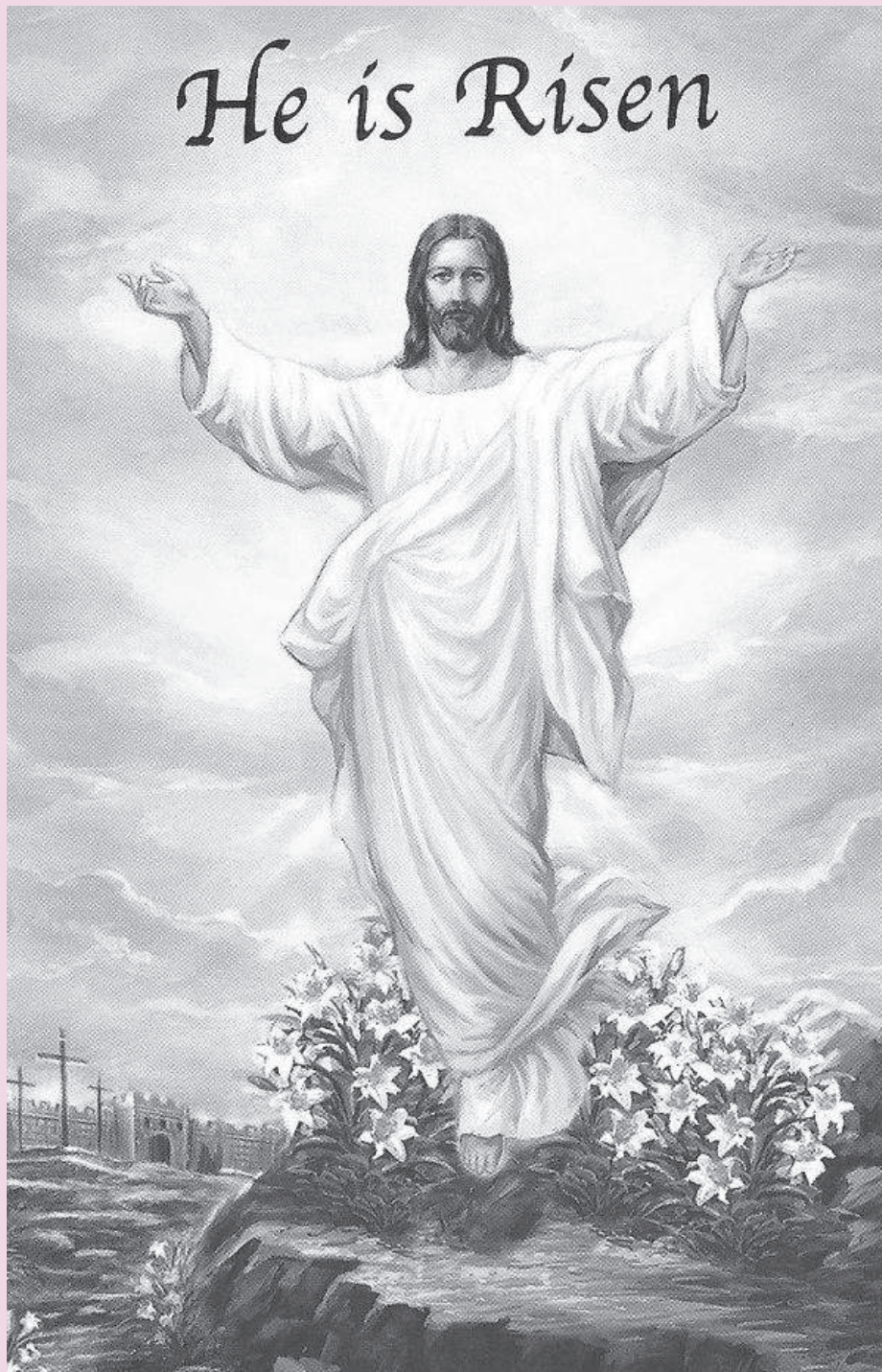

**Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,
Easter blessings. Christ is risen, risen indeed!**

Faith Formation 6-12

High School: Immediate Prep for Confirmation Option 6 continues Monday, April 21, 6:00-7:45pm at SJ.

Registrations for 2014-2015: The handbook containing middle and high school programs and registration forms is available at the Parish Office and on our website. Because there is a summer option, registrations need to be returned by June 1. For our Family Formation program, next year's 5th graders, who have an older sibling in the program and the 5th grader is the youngest in the family, may also participate in the family approach.

St. Joseph Regional Catholic School News: What's Happening in our Spanish Classes

We were excited to add a weekly 6th grade Spanish class this year, giving our 6th graders exposure to the language before delving into the 7th and 8th grade Spanish curriculum. At the 6th grade level we've covered the alphabet, numbers, and colors as well as some basic vocabulary themed around the seasons and holidays. The 7th graders have just finished a unit called *Nuevas clases, nuevos amigos* and they can now talk about classes, schedules, likes, and dislikes. Our 8th graders have just finished their unit entitled *Que te gustaria hacer?* during which they discussed what they prefer to do in their free time versus the things they have to do. All students get added practice with an interactive website they can access from home. Later this spring, Mrs. Croteau is hoping to set up "Skype" sessions with some students from Spain so our students can practice their conversational skills.

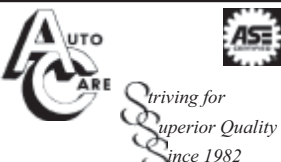
