



On behalf of Bishop Libasci, we would like to invite you to a special Mass to pray for those suffering from the violence in Syria and the Middle East. This special Mass is scheduled to take place at Saint Joseph Cathedral in Manchester, New Hampshire, on **Thursday, May 1, 2014, at 6:30 p.m.**

Bishop Libasci will be the principal celebrant of the Mass with Father Joseph I. Khoueiry, Pastor of Saint George Maronite Catholic Church in Dover and Father Thomas P. Steinmetz, Pastor of Our Lady of the Cedars in Manchester, as concelebrants.
