“But a Samaritan traveler who came upon him was moved
with compassion at the sight.” - Lk 10:33

Reflection 7-10-2016

In today's parable of the Good Samaritan, Jesus confirms the Old Testament teaching that "eternal life" depends on love of God and love of neighbor. He shocks his audience, though, by naming a Samaritan as the one who sacrifices for a man who is not only a stranger, but an Israelite, would have scorned Samaritans. Regarding the Samaritan's unconditional love, Jesus tells us, "Go and do likewise!" (v. 37).

We too have neighbors in desperate need of help. Justine's article last week cited the 20/20 TV segment "The Drug Epidemic in NH," documenting the people in our midst who are suffering from drug addiction. Those around us are suffering in other ways as well, from ailments both physical and emotional. Our Neighbors need to hear the Good News that, even with the challenges of life, Jesus wants to--and can!--give us "abundant life" (Jn 10:10)

In a few weeks, we of Saints Mary and Joseph have a chance to witness to the reality of abundant life in Jesus as we gather at the Field of Dreams for an afternoon of musical performances by Christian musicians from our parish and from other area churches. The event will serve as our annual social, our opportunity to spend relaxing time with fellow church members while listening to inspirational Christian music, but the event will also be for people outside the parish, our invitation to them to come and see the joy and love evident among us. What better way for us to "love our neighbor" than by witnessing as community to the reality of abundant life?

What's Happening at Kids Church

In July we will be on An Island Getaway with Jesus!

Let the little children come to me! was the warm welcome that the little ones received as our island getaway began!

Upon arrival, the little ones were able to choose a flowered lei and engage in our island themed sensory centers. The sand, water, and shell sorting centers were very popular! The focus of our *object lesson* was that *God loves us just the way we are and fills our hearts with joy and excitement!* (the children each had a marker colored red heart on a paper towel surrounded by smaller outlined hearts) The large red heart represented what our hearts look like when we are filled with God's love. God doesn't want us to stop there! There are some empty hearts of people all around us! God wants us to share His love with others. How can we do that? (the little ones placed the bottom of their paper towel into the shallow water, as the water was absorbed, the red marker from the large heart spread to the smaller outlined hearts) When we allow God to fill our lives, His love will overflow and spread to others! By showing others that we are friends with Jesus, they will want to be His friend too and their hearts will be filled with God's love, just like ours! Jesus wants everyone to be His friend!
