
Saints Mary & Joseph Parish June 7, 2015 Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ



FEAST OF THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST

In 1999, I spent six months at the Maryknoll Language School in Cochabamba, Bolivia, studying Spanish. During my stay in Bolivia, I experienced the culture of these people and how it influenced the practice of their Christian faith. Holy days in South America are also holidays and they are celebrated with great solemnity. This is especially manifested in the Holy Week celebrations and major feasts.

I lived in a Jesuit residence which was close by the city's public plaza. On one corner of the plaza was the Cathedral of the Archdiocese of Cochabamba and diagonally opposite the Cathedral was the Jesuit Church. The Feast of Corpus Christi was celebrated on the actual date, the Thursday after Trinity Sunday, and not transferred to Sunday as here in the United States. At each of the corners of the plaza, a small, very decorated altar or shrine was built and in front of the Cathedral, a flat-bed truck was parked decorated with numerous flowers and plants and an altar.

The celebration commenced when the Archbishop exited the Cathedral carrying the monstrance. A band led the procession, followed by a contingent of soldiers, and women scattered flower petals in front of the Archbishop carrying the monstrance. At each corner altar/shrine, the Archbishop blessed the people. When the procession circumvented the plaza, the Archbishop ascended the flat-bed truck and a Solemn Benediction was celebrated. After this benediction, the Archbishop returned the monstrance to the Cathedral.

As soon as the Archbishop exited the platform, the people rushed onto the platform and began taking the various decorations, flowers, etc. I wondered what was happening as it seemed that they were vandalizing the altar. However, it then occurred to me that they were gathering mementoes, almost as relics, which they would bring home and place in their home shrines which all families have in their houses.

This outward piety which I characterize as religiosity is a manifestation of how Latinos worship according to their culture and how included in this adoration is a great deal of emotion which they are not reluctant to openly profess. Pope Francis has often spoken to this phenomenon especially when he makes reference to the poor and the marginalized. Our culture is reluctant to manifest such emotional devotion although it was very much part of our pre-Vatican II worship when Eucharistic reception was infrequent, the Mass was said in Latin, and daily Mass was quite early in the morning. Our need to be involved in communal devotion was concretized in novenas, missions and other types of devotions.

You can sign up online at www.parishpay.com. Simply enter 03079 in the zip code area and you will be directed to Saints Mary and Joseph Parish. Donations are transferred from your checking or savings account once a month. This will also save us the cost of sending out envelopes. You can also give electronically through PayPal on the parish web-site.




