Reflection 02-21-2016

“This is my chosen Son, listen to him....”

These are the words from the Holy Gospel. Spoken from God, our Father in Heaven. How can we listen to Jesus? What other voices, commands, stories, gossip, clutter our minds everyday? Daily “blah, blah, blah,”...gets in the way.

Stop for a minute. Picture Jesus on the mountain top. Dazzling white clothing, hands stretched out to you. Hear what he has to say...I love you. You are my child. Tell me what is on your mind. Daily worries and concerns can be erased. I can help. Take time for yourself, especially during this Holy season of Lent. Thank God for all your gifts and treasures in your life.

Walk with Jesus in the desert. Feel the heat. Look at the dry, barren land. All your questions cleared from your mind. You remember the journey of Jesus during Lent and what occurs during Holy Week and what He did for us.


Jesus is still in dazzling white. You are listening to Him. Each day listen for a word or phrase from Him. Do not be afraid. He is always with you, as He was with the Apostles. Feel calm and content. If He were to walk up to you while you were shopping, how would you greet Him? Would you turn your head, walk away, take his hand, or just stand in awe?? Maybe other times during your life you have encountered Jesus!!! Was He in dazzling white, or was He the homeless person on the sidewalk???

Always welcome Jesus...never turn away. You can see Jesus in others...just as He was transfigured before the eyes of the Apostles. You never know how we may be changed or “transfigured” in our lifetime.

Welcome Fr. Al Hicks, SJ



Father Al graduated from Sacred Heart High School in Newton Centre, MA in 1953, and then entered the Society of Jesus (SJ). He studied the usual courses in the Society of Jesus, and has always considered himself to have been over-educated! Between studies in Philosophy and Theology, he was sent to Baghdad to teach our forever and always-beloved Iraqi students. Father claims that they all looked older and somewhat brighter than he, but together they plowed through the Grimm Fairy Tales in English, as well as courses in Mathematics and Religion.

Returning to Theology, Fr. Al was ordained in 1966 and then sent back to Baghdad in 1968. Since there was a need for Math teachers at Baghdad College, he earned a degree in Mathematics from Wesleyan University (CT). When all were expelled from Iraq in 1969 he was sent to Boston College High School to teach Math, and there he remained for 22 years. In 1991 he had the good fortune to become the Principal of Nativity Preparatory School in Roxbury, MA. Like their Iraqi counterparts, the Roxbury students continue to hold a very special place in his heart. In 2002 Fr. Al returned to the Middle East and joined a small Jesuit community in Amman, Jordan which was established to bolster their small Christian community. He stayed there for 13 years, and finally returned to the US in July 2015. Fr. Al is happy to be serving our parish community in Salem as a Senior Priest in Residence and we are so glad to have him here!!


