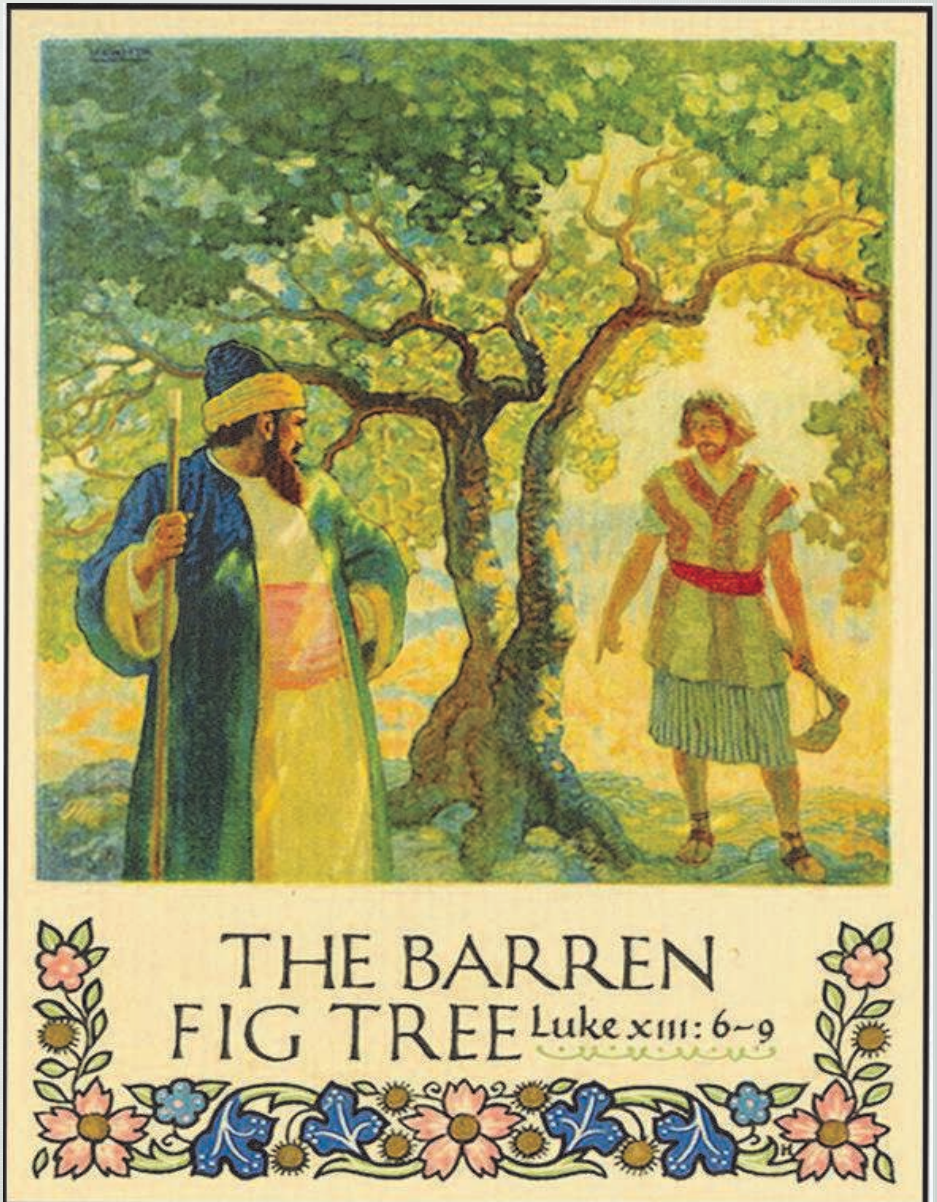

**Reflection 2-28-16**

**Meeting God in the everyday**

It's a bedtime ritual in many families: Tucking their son or daughter into bed at the end of the day, Mom and Dad ask "How was your day?" and, snuggling up close, the child shares the latest news from school and playground.

But one mother asks the question a little differently. As she tucks her children into bed each night, she asks, "Where did you meet God today?" And they tell her:

"A teacher helped me . . . "

"There was a homeless person in the park . . . "

"I saw a tree with lots of flowers on it . . . "

And Mom tells them where and how she met God that day, too.

Before the children drop off to sleep, the stuff of the day becomes the substance of prayer. \*

This weekend's Gospel, the parable of the fig tree, is Jesus' assurance that the God of mercy and compassion is in our midst, that God's love – which knows neither limit nor condition – is ours in every moment we live. Like the patient and merciful gardener in the parable, God continues to see our worth despite our failings and calls forth that goodness within each of us. The Gospel fig tree is an invitation to hope in the unlimited love of our God.

"We think our life is important to ourselves alone," Thomas Merton wrote, "and do not know that our life is more important to the Living God than it is to our own selves. We think our happiness is for ourselves alone and do not realize that it is God's happiness. We think our sorrows are for ourselves alone, and do not believe that they are much more than that: they are God's sorrows. There is nothing we can steal from God at all, because before we can think of stealing it, it has already been given."

May our Lenten journey with Jesus this year enable us to see God's mercy and grace bringing new life to the struggling fig tree that is every one of our lives.

**Statement from the Diocese of Manchester regarding Our Lady of Mount Carmel Catholic Mission in Salem.**

It has come to the attention of the Diocese of Manchester that a group which calls itself "A Religious Congregation of Mary Immaculate Queen" ("CMRI") has established a church in Salem by the name of "Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Mission." On its website, this group indicates that it offers the Tridentine Rite Mass and other sacraments. CMRI is not in communion with the Roman Catholic Church, and does not recognize Pope Francis as head of the Church. ***Catholics are not permitted to receive the sacraments from CMRI ministers*** except when in danger of death.

This statement is issued out of pastoral and spiritual concern for those who may erroneously present themselves for reception of the sacraments at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Mission. If you have any questions about the relationship between CMRI and the Roman Catholic Church, please contact your pastor. For those who have a desire to attend a celebration of the Tridentine Rite Mass within the Church in union with the Holy See, please note that Saint Patrick parish in Nashua offers the Latin Mass Saturday mornings at 8:00 a.m. and on the second Sunday of each month at noon.
