
Saints Mary & Joseph Parish August 2, 2015



St. Ignatius Loyola

This past July 31st was the Feast of St. Ignatius of Loyola, the Founder of the Society of Jesus, commonly known as Jesuits (which originally was a term of opprobrium). Pope Francis is a Jesuit and was the first Jesuit ever elected to be the Pope (something that was believed would never happen for various reasons); he is also the Bishop of Rome and often refers to himself by this title which has great implications for Christian unity. The three priests that serve here in Sts. Mary and Joseph Parish are all Jesuits.

St. Ignatius was born in 1491 in Spain and was a Basque nobleman who enjoyed courtly life, dancing, singing, women, dueling and getting into brawls. In 1521, he suffered serious wounds to both legs when the French forces invaded Navarre, Spain. In his vanity, he had the legs re-broken because he feared that he would walk with a limp. His legs did not heal properly and he did walk with a limp for the rest of his life.

While recuperating, he underwent a religious conversion and decided to dedicate his life to God. During this very long religious experience, he developed what was to become known as the Spiritual Exercises which was a retreat of thirty days. The Spiritual Exercises today and over the years have been adapted to fit various occasions. In 1534, Ignatius traveled to Paris to enroll in the university and while there, he attracted a number of young men whom he directed in the Spiritual Exercise, among who was St. Francis Xavier. This group of young men was to form the foundation of a new religious order and Pope Paul III officially approved the Society of Jesus in 1540.

There existed in the Church what were known as mendicant orders who depended on charity for their livelihood e.g. Franciscans, Dominicans who were founded in the 13th century and they became known as religious priests and brothers. However, the Jesuits were to be an updated mendicant order and would not be confined to a particular monastery or sing the Divine Office but instead would live and work in the world.

There exists a basic difference between priests who are known as diocesan or secular priests and religious priests. Secular priests work under a bishop or archbishop in a particular diocese or archdiocese, take a vow of celibacy, make a promise to a particular bishop but do not take a vow of poverty and receive a salary with benefits and insurance. Religious priests take the three vows of poverty, chastity and obedience. They usually live in a community and belong to a province with a provincial as their major superior.

The Society of Jesus is the largest order in the Church and numbers about 15,000 in the world. It is also the largest missionary order in the Church and exists in most countries. It is involved in just about every type of apostolic work and ministry. Just recently, a Fr. John W. O'Malley, S.J., probably the foremost American Church historian living today, has published a short and very readable history of the Jesuits, entitled "The Jesuits, a History from Ignatius to the Present."




