
# Saints Mary & Joseph Parish August 23, 2015



### Reflection 8-23-15

"I urgently appeal," says Pope Francis in his new encyclical, "for a new dialogue about how we are shaping the future of our planet" (*LS* 14). In our country, where we often hear complaints of "partisan politics," we could see the Pope's appeal as naïve, as doomed to fail through the universality of human selfishness—but the teachings of Jesus himself might be considered naïve. After all, how many people, being *forced* to walk a mile, would immediately *volunteer* to go another mile?! (see Mt 5:41). Jesus does not *expect* many people to accept and live out his teachings, "Narrow is the path to life" (Mt 7:14)), but he *invites* us all, and "rejoices" whenever a "lost sheep" (see Lk 15:1-7) recognizes the Holy Spirit at work in her life and says 'yes' to the "fullness of life" (Jn 10:10) Jesus offers. This 'yes' is not an abstraction. The first disciples said 'yes' to the physical person of Jesus, and today we say 'yes' to the physical members of the Church, "because it is Christ's body" (Eph 5:30, today's 2<sup>nd</sup> reading). In particular, we say 'yes' to the pope as the visible head of the Body. Our 'yes' is no abstraction, and neither is "fullness of life". One attains Life by recognizing the miraculous role she is invited to play in Christ's work of salvation, as it unfolds through his Body, the Church. Jesus still performs miracles today, for anyone with ears to hear and eyes to see (see Mt 3:16).

Channel 17 taped the closing assembly and I will let you know when it will be aired on Salem Community TV. My sincere appreciation to everyone involved that made this year so memorable!!






### **Young Adults**
