### Long-Range Planning Becomes Medium-Range

On March 2<sup>nd</sup>, Fr. Tom and I spent almost one and a half hours talking with Bishop Peter. He expressed his appreciation for all of the hard work that the Long-Range Planning Committee did in researching and compiling the report. He asked our take on the future of the school, the present status of the parish, and the unique culture of each church-campus. He was heartened to know that the efforts made to establish a second family Mass are bearing fruit and that we are experimenting with a 5 PM Sunday Mass. The fact that we are attracting young families to the 9:30 and 11 AM contemporary music Masses was encouraging to him. He also was appreciative of the fact that the Jesuits will remain for at least a few more years.

After much mutual conversation, his advice was that we continue to work to grow the parish with young families. He hopes that this will allow the parish to continue with two sites and allow the growth of the finances so that we can care for all of the parish needs. He is willing to put up some diocesan parish mutual aid funds for the next year or two while we grow the parish to where it can pay all of its bills.

I was reminded of the parable of Jesus about the unfruitful fig tree. The farmer is given more time to hoe around it and manure it so that it will bear fruit. In effect, Bishop Peter is telling us that the church in Salem is beginning to bear more fruit and so, rather than taking the drastic action of closing one church, we are to continue to work for its growth. For this to happen all of the members of the church will need to become evangelists, inviting our neighbors and new people in the community to come and worship with us. May God shower Salem with a new outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#### THE IGNATIAN EXAMEN

The *examen* prayer, in two parts, is essential to Ignatian spirituality. The *general examen* is done spontaneously each evening by Christians when they review their day to recollect how they were or were not acting as Christ. A yardstick for review can be the "fruit of the Spirit, … love, joy, peace, etc." (Gal 5:22, Phil 4:4-7), or St. Paul's famous passage on love (1 Cor 13:4-7). St. Ignatius suggests we look for patterns in our daily behavior, asking, "What events in my life tend to rob me of love, joy, peace, etc.? What attitudes of mine lead to my negative behaviors?"

To go beyond mere review and achieve *transformation*, I apply the *particular examen* to *one* of my faults. I can do this in about thirty seconds, first thing in the morning, by asking God to help me during the day to recognize the times I might give into my fault, and to help me grow in the knowledge of how I can replace my fault with its corresponding virtue. I focus on the same fault long enough (days, weeks ...) to allow God's grace to work in me. This brief prayer is miraculously effective because it puts my desire for transformation in the back of my mind from where it can leap into consciousness at the first promptings of the Holy Spirit. My general examen can now help me to monitor—and give thanks for—the daily progress with which God will be blessing me. *Fr. Frink*
