

We would also like to give a big thank you to North Salem Elementary School for their huge truck load of food items. We were truly thankful for your generosity too.



SJRCS Math News

Currently, our 6th grade students are spending a lot of time studying 2-Dimensional and 3-Dimensional geometric shapes. They have found the areas and perimeters of squares and rectangles, triangles, parallelograms, trapezoids and irregular figures. We have moved on to study different types of Polyhedra (3-Dimensional shapes) and will learn how to find their surface areas as well as the volume of these figures. Additionally, 6th grade will examine the characteristics of circles, including the diameter and radius and how they relate to pi, circumference and area.

The 7th grade students have just finished their unit on Rational and Irrational numbers, including learning about the Pythagorean Theorem. They will be moving into a unit on Geometry, reviewing angles and polygons, and then learning about angles that are formed when 2 or more parallel lines are intersected by a third line - a transversal. From there they will also work on Area, Surface Area and Volume.

The 8th Grade Pre-Algebra Class is also in the middle of their Geometry unit. They spent time learning about angles formed by intersecting lines, parallel lines cut by a transversal, proving that figures were either congruent or similar and finding the angle sums of polygons. Currently, we are studying transformations of shapes, such as reflections, translations and rotations.

The 8th Grade Algebra students are in the middle of a unit on Systems of Equations and Inequalities. They have learned to find the solution of two equations by graphing, using substitution or elimination. They have studied equations of lines and can determine whether the equation represents parallel lines or perpendicular lines and have learned which of these have no solutions, infinitely many solutions, or only one solution. As this unit progresses, the students will learn about systems of linear inequalities and how to graph these systems.

As you can see, we are a very busy bunch of junior high math students!!




