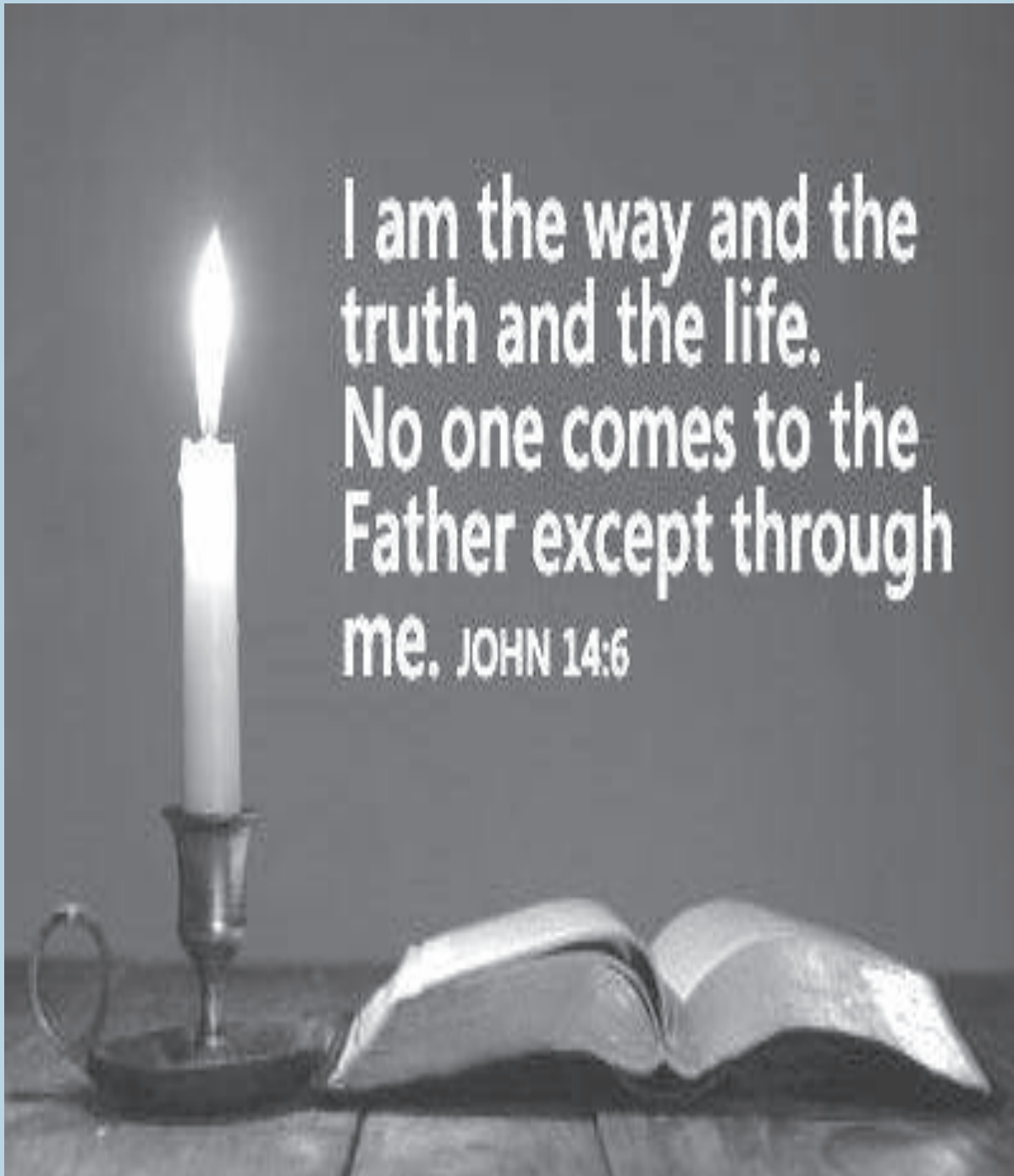

**Family Promise Ministry**

Family Promise of Greater Rockingham County is a non-profit organization whose goal is to create a local interfaith hospitality network that assists homeless families in securing permanent housing. Six local congregations have committed to participate by being a "Host" Congregation providing a week's overnight housing, hospitality, meals for 3-5 families from 5:30pm-7am. Families are bused to the Center where they can shower, do laundry, and care for preschool age children. There they will be able to use the Day Center's address and phone to look for employment and housing. The Day Center provides a full-time director who provides intensive case management and classes to help these families regain their independence. Also, at the Center the families are offered education in budgeting, nutrition and parenting as well as help in developing job skills. Family Promise also provides transportation to and from the host congregation as well as to other appointments. Family Promise is seeking volunteers to work at the local host congregation – St. David's Episcopal Church the week of May 18th and the week of June 15th. Volunteers are needed to provide and serve an evening meal for 2 families, or stay 1 overnight at the church to offer onsite support, or be at the church in the morning to help with breakfast. 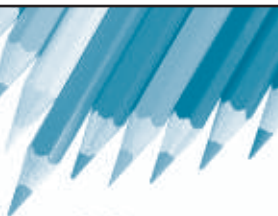
