Pentecost 2014!

On June 8th we celebrate Pentecost, the day the Holy Spirit came upon the Apostles, empowering them to proclaim the Gospel with boldness and confirming their message with miraculous healings. Each year, in preparation for the feast of Pentecost, the Church invites us to pray the *Novena to the Holy Spirit*, that we ourselves might be filled anew with the gifts of the Spirit. The prayers of the novena are said for nine days, from the day after Ascension (Fri. May 30th) to the day before Pentecost (Sat. June 7th).
