

# **Our New School Principal**

The Catholic Schools Office is please to announce the appointment of Noreen Marie McAloon as the principal of St. Joseph Regional Catholic School in Salem. Mrs. McAloon is a long-time elementary and secondary school educator. She has taught in Catholic schools in NH and NY. She has experience as an assistant principal and principal in the public sector. She has also taught religious education classes for many years in local parishes.

Mrs. McAloon holds a Bachelor of Science in Elementary Education, with a minor in English, from St. John's University (NY). She earned a Master of Science in Reading from C.W. Post Center of Long Island University. She also holds a CAGS from Plymouth State University and an Ed.D. from Argosy University, both in educational leader-ship. She received certification as a superintendent, principal, reading specialist, elementary school teacher, and curriculum coordinator from the State of New Hampshire.

The first students for St. Joseph Regional Catholic School were welcomed in September of 1959 by two nuns belonging to the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur. The newly-constructed school building included the auditorium, eight classrooms on the main floor, and an unfinished lower level. Only two of the classrooms were used initially for grades one and two, but the plan was to open a new grade each year. This happened much sooner than expected, and by 1963, one class for each of the eight grades had been filled. The Kindergarten and Pre-school, which had been run by St. Joseph Parish, became part of the school in 2011.
