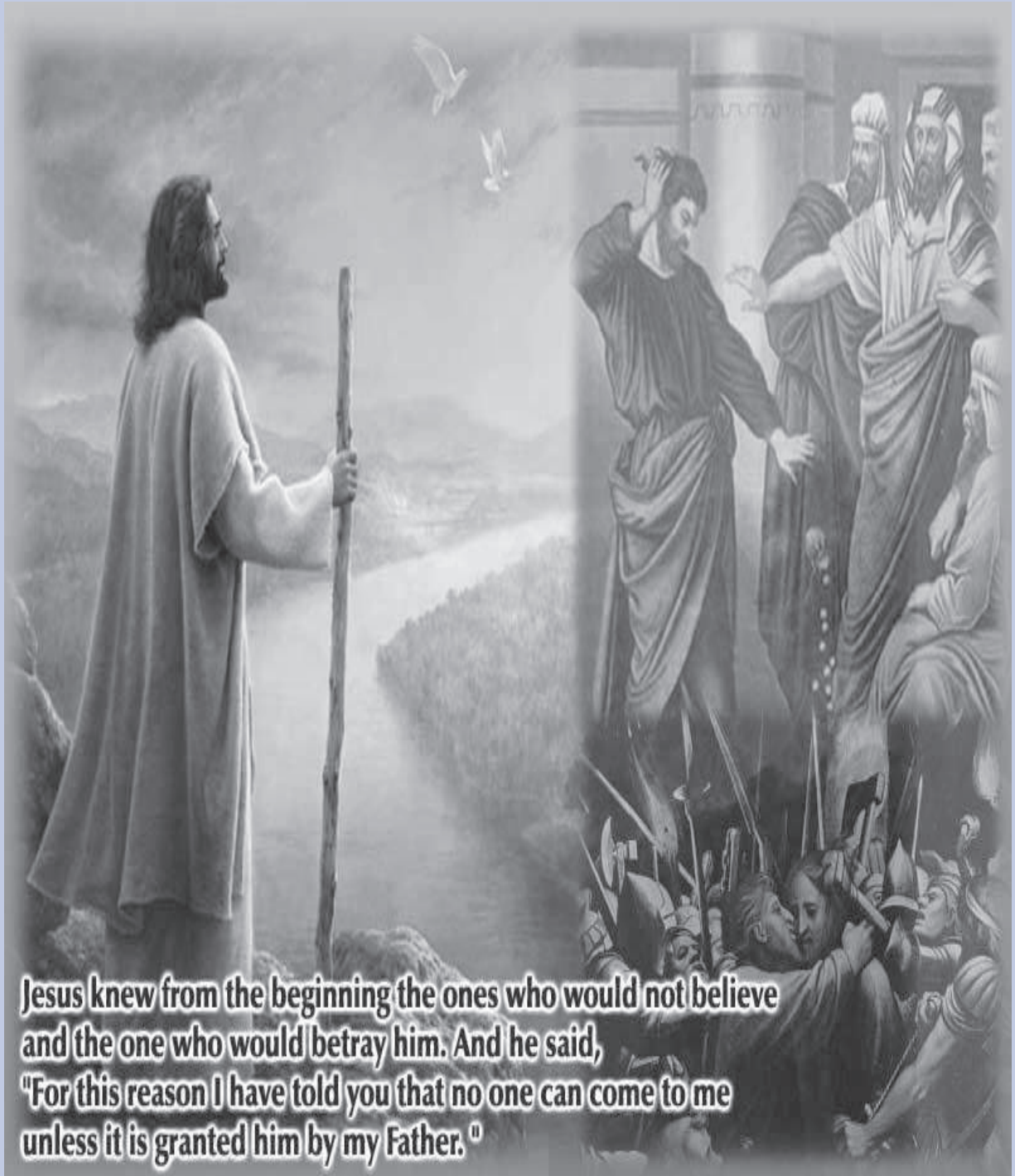

Honduras News

Health Update on Padre Richard Donahue

As you may have heard Padre fell in his home back in July and this is part of a letter we received regarding his health:

“Today I write to you from Honduras to tell you of the health of Padre Richard Donahue, Founder and President of the Olancho Aid Foundation, Inc. Padre fell in his home on July 11th and was transported to the hospital in Tegucigalpa, Honduras. There the doctors found it necessary to perform 2 surgeries to stop the bleeding in his head. Padre Donahue’s speech and mobility are extremely limited and it was quickly decided that he had to be airlifted back to the U.S., but to do so it cost the organization over \$30,000.”

Padre Donahue went to Honduras over 24 years ago and has been building schools the last 16 years. If you would like to support the work of the Olancho Aid Foundation and Padre Donahue’s dream please contact Mary Roy. He has given so much of himself to Honduras and to all of us who have worked with him.

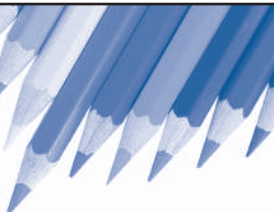
