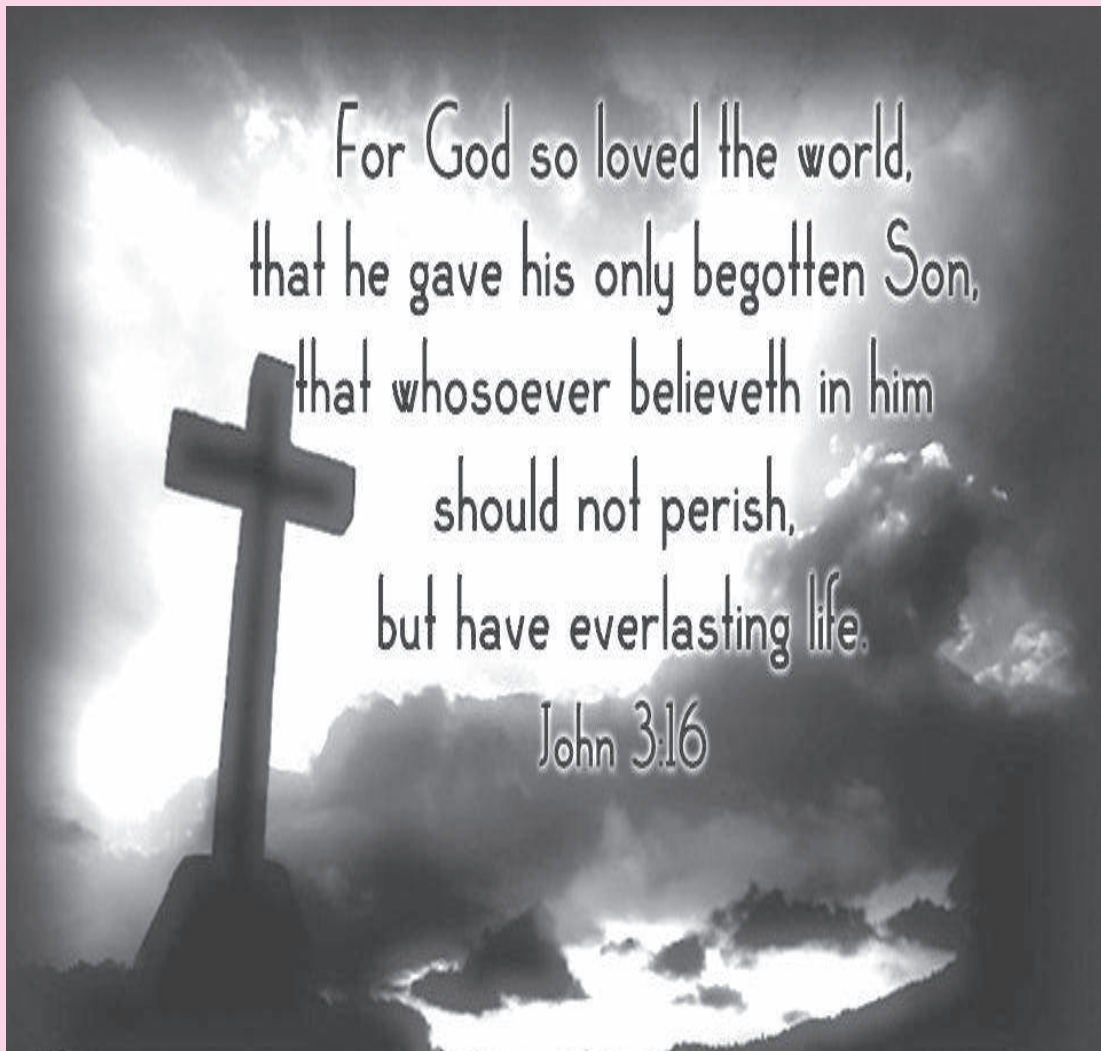

Laetare Sunday

Today, the 4th Sunday of Lent, was formerly referred to as Laetare Sunday and marked the mid-point of the Lenten Season. Laetare is the Latin word ‘to rejoice’ and it was taken from the Entrance Antiphon of today’s Liturgy of Mass. This antiphon quotes Isaiah 66:10-11: “Rejoice, Jerusalem, all who love her. Be joyful all who were in morning.” Laetare Sunday had a great deal more meaning when Lent was a much more penitential season and before the changes of the Second Vatican Council. In that time, every day, except Sunday, was a day of strict fast and meat could only be eaten at the main meal of the day. Also, Wednesdays and Fridays of Lent were days of abstinence from meat. Thus, Laetare Sunday was a symbol that Lent was half completed and an encouragement to continue the penitential practices of the season.

Although we may rejoice that the Lenten Season is half completed, there are greater reasons for rejoicing and these can be found in today’s Liturgy of the Word. St. Paul reminds us in the second reading that “...God who is rich in mercy and because of his great love for us has brought us to life in Christ Jesus and by his grace we have been saved.” In today’s gospel, Jesus, in conversation with Nicodemus, emphasizes that his Father so loved the world that he gave us his only Son, so that everyone who believes in Jesus might have eternal life. Our gift of faith and our belief in Jesus Christ are the real reasons why we should rejoice in this Lenten Season. *Fr. Bill Mulligan*

Honduras Update

The Honduran Mission team had another great trip that went by so fast we had trouble keeping up. The team began by judging the science fair at the bilingual high school and then off to tour all the schools that padre and the foundation oversee. It was a beautiful warm (I am gloating) day that ended with many of the team going to the orphanage to play with the children there. On our second day we drove to a community to paint the inside and outside of a church – what a transformation. We enjoyed seeing it finished and for most of the day we worked side by side with some of the parishioners. Our third day was filled with church as we got up early to go to the funeral of the man who donated the land where the Nazareth is built and then head over to see Padre Donahue celebrate his first mass since he was sick. It was a joyous sight and I for one was happy to see Padre back doing what he loves. After mass we threw a birthday party for the children at the orphanage and we were all kept busy trying to keep up with 37 happy and excited children. Each child got a costume thanks to one of our team, party gift bags, cake and milk and a chance to break a piñata. Great fun was had by all. On our 4th day we traveled one hour to paint a classroom and the back side of a government school, but when we walked into their outside auditorium we were greeted with 600 happy voices. We felt like rock stars!!! We got to hear and see Honduran music and dance and were blown away at this cultural gift that they shared with us. Painting after that was sweet.
