

Ten March Activities for Catholic Families



1. **Find a coloring or activity page about a March saint**, such as this free St. Katharine Drexel activity packet (March 3rd): <https://www.reallifeathome.com/saint-katharine-drexel-printables-worksheets/>
2. **Write in a prayer journal or work on a craft to decorate a new one to start using or to give to someone as a gift.** The things we know about Saints Perpetua and Felicity are because of a journal kept by Saint Perpetua. (March 7th)
3. **Go to a book store story time or just take time to enjoy a fun time at the book store.** St. John of God, the patron saint of booksellers, has his feast day on March 8th.
